MLA teachers are among the most qualified and experienced in Calgary, all having approved teaching certification, graduate degrees as well as extensive overseas experience.


The learning environment and atmosphere at Maple Leaf Academy is relaxed and conducive to the serious language learner whose priority is acquiring practical and academic English skills.

Our ESL programs are aimed at students over the age of eighteen (18) who have graduated from High School.

All students must provide letters from themselves detailing why they would like to study at the Academy (Letter of Intent). This can be attached as a scanned or typed document.

Program Information

Maple Leaf Academy offers:

- Intensive instrtion in ESL training with low student/teacher ratio
- Maximum of 16 students per class
- Subjects cover listening/speaking, reading, writing/grammar, pronunciation and Canadian culture
- Students can register for any number of weeks with a minimum of one (1) week starting on every Monday
- Students enrolling in our ESL Academic program must qualify by passing an MLA placement test. MLA accepts students at the level equivalent to the <u>Canadian Language Benchmarks</u> 1 to 7.

Immigration Regulations

Please contact the High Commission, Embassy or Consulate in your country for the current immigration regulations. If the country where you reside does not have a Canadian Consulate, write to the one nearest to you or contact our school for more information. All international ESL students who wish to study for a period longer than six months require a Study Permit.

To apply for a Study Permit, a person must get an "Official Letter of Acceptance" (LOA) from the school. An "Official Letter of Acceptance" is issued after all Fees have been paid for the length of the time registered.

Medical Insurance and Health Care

Each student must show proof of medical insurance and liability coverage before being admitted to Maple Leaf Academy.

*If you do not have medical insurance options, Maple Leaf Academy offers student insurance at an extra cost.

Non-Canadian students, who intend to stay in Alberta for 12 consecutive months or more, will be permitted to apply for Alberta Health Care Insurance coverage.

Acceptance Procedure

- 1. Upon receipt and evaluation of the requirements, MLA will notify the student regarding acceptance.
- 2. Once accepted, the student will receive a Provisional **Letter of Acceptance**, and an invoice requesting payment of fees. Payments must be payable to MAPLE LEAF ACADEMY by certified cheque, bank draft, or wire transfer in Canadian funds. All service charges are the responsibility of the student.
- 3. Upon receipt of the fees (registration and tuition), the student will receive an OFFICIAL LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE and an OFFICIAL RECEIPT via email. The student should then print 2 copies of the LOA. One copy should be presented to the Canadian Consulate in the student's country, so that a permit may be issued. The other is for the student's personal records. The student should also carry a copy of the LOA when travelling and a copy should also be left with the student's parents or guardians in their home country.

Homestay

Maple Leaf Academy offers a homestay program for International Students who wish to experience Canadian family living. This is a great learning experience to enhance and learn Canadian Culture and the language. For further information or assistance, please contact Maple Leaf Academy.

*Monthly fee is determined by meal arrangement. First and last month payments are due on the first day of homestay.

You qualify for the LINC program if you:

- are a permanent resident or have refugee status
- are not a Canadian citizen
- have an English language assessment within the LINC level

To register for LINC Instruction:

- 1. Phone the Immigrant Language Vocational Assessment and Referral Centre -ILVARC- (403-262-2656) and make an appointment for a language assessment test.
- 2. Meet with a counsellor at ILVARC to learn about language training opportunities.
- 3. Visit Maple Leaf Academy.

 - Your Language Assessment from ILVARC or
 - Your Recent LINC Certificate
